Divisional Citation of Unit..... Award of Purple HeartII

I. DIVISIONAL CITATION OF UNIT. Company B, 83d Chemical Battalion, for exceptionally meritorious conduct in support of infantry troops in combat on 12 December 1944 in France. On the morning of 12 December 1944, Company B, 83d Chemical Battalion, was supporting the 141st Infantry Regimental Compat Team from positions near a strategically important town. Without warning, the company was surrounded and their mortar positions overrun by numerically superior enemy troops who had infiltrated through the densely wooded terrain. The members of Company B, whose mortars were located in the narrow space between the woods and the town, immediately directed heavy small arms fire at the onrushing enemy from their inferior, downhill position, and fought with such valor and determination that they delayed the attackers, providing sufficient time for the deployment of reserve units. The intensity of the hostile assault forced the mortannen to withdraw to the outskirts of town where they hastily replenished their supply of small arms ammunition and joined the counterattacking force in a strong thrust which cleared their overrun positions. Then, while still under heavy automatic weapons fire, they directed effective mortar concentrations which completely disorganized and hastened the retreat of the hostile force.
